Indoor Worship Plans

We are happy to announce that indoor worship has been approved starting June 27th in the sanctuary. We will have indoor worship every Sunday at 10am starting the 27th through September 5th.

What will this look like?

- 1) Sign up. People still need to sign up. We will have 100 slots and also an overflow wait list so we know when there is enough interest to start two services. If you signed up for outdoor worship for June 27th or beyond, your spot is still reserved indoors.
- 2) **Masks:** Please bring a mask. Unvaccinated people are asked to be masked at all times indoors. Vaccinated people only need to wear a mask for singing.
- 3) **Physical Distancing**: With 100 spots, we will ask those that would like to physically distance to be on the left side of the sanctuary (we will have signs).
- 4) **Child Care and Godly Play**: We will offer both childcare for infants through age 2 and also Godly Play for 3-5 year old children beginning June 27th. To make this as low risk as possible:
 - <u>Sign up (on the worship sign up)</u> no later than 7am on Sunday morning so we know how many caregivers we will need.
 - Children age 3 and up are masked.
 - Caregivers are vaccinated and will also be masked.
 - We will have as much outdoors as possible (in the courtyard and playground) for Godly Play and
 potentially other large open spaces in the church if there is poor weather.
- 5) **Bulletins/Collection/Slides:** We will not have ushers or bulletins. We ask that you use your mobile device link, the church app, or print out the bulletin at home. We will have slides, so if you would like to run the slides please <u>let the</u> office know. We will have a basket for collection offerings, but we will not be passing it through the pews.
- 6) **Recorded Worship**: During July the staff will be taking a break from offering new recorded video worship. Instead we will record the sermon for the podcast and have it available the following day. We will also have a link to past recorded videos. Thank you for your understanding of this needed break.
